New Bill is Remarkable in the History of Tariff Legislation Because of Genuine Downward Revision in Favor of Consumers—New System of Taxation Shifts Burden From Poor to Wealthy—Reciprocity is Favored.

WASHINGTON, April 7.—The sixty-third congress—Democratic—called in extraordinary session by President Wilson, came into being at noon today.

As presented to the house today, with the approval of President Wilson, this dual measure is regarded as being the forerunner of a new commercial and economic era in this country from which these tangible results will spring.
