TARTAR AT LAUREL LANDS HANDICAP

Butler's Two-Year-Old Kilkenny Boy Makes New Sprint Record.

LAUREL, Oct. 31.—Tartar, R. T. Wilson's 4-year-old gelding, was winner of the National Handicap, Laurel Park's big feature race of the October meeting. James Butler kept up his winning streak by taking the 2-year-old handicap at 54 furlongs with Kilkenny Boy, son of Hippodrome—Maid of Erin. Kilkenny Boy had the top weight of 118 pounds. He was ridden by Butler, who was pacesetter in the stretch and was away at the end. The first half-mile was covered in 46 4-5, and the five and a half furlongs in 1:05 4-5, which broke the track record of 1:05 2-5, made by Kilkenny some days ago.
