## BILL V3.

An Act respecting The Casualty Company of Canada.

WHEREAS a petition has been presented praying that Preamble. it be enacted as hereinafter set forth and it is expe-<sup>1911, c. 63.</sup> dient to grant the prayer of the said petition: Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice of the Senate and 5 House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:

1. Nothwithstanding aynthing in section 78 of The Extension of Insurance Act, 1910, or in the Act, chapter 63 of the statutes obtaining of 1911, incorporating The Casualty Company of Canada, license. the said chapter shall be deemed not to have expired and 1910, c. 32, 78

10 ceased to be in force after the nineteenth day of May, 1913, but to have continued and to be in force, for all purposes thereof whatsoever, until the nineteenth day of May, 1914; and the Minister of Finance may, at any time not later than the nineteenth day of May, 1914, and subject 15 to all other provisions of *The Insurance Act, 1910*, grant

to that company the license necessary for carrying on business.

2. If the company has not obtained the said license Effect of by the nineteenth day of May, 1914, the said chapter 63 license. 20 shall then expire and cease to be in force thereafter, except

for the sole purpose of winding up the company's business, but otherwise shall remain in full force and effect for all purposes thereof whatsoever.
