CORRECTION.

Bulletin No. 298, page 8, Milk Sample No. 62375, collected June 12, 1914, at Valleyfield

It has been learned by the Department that this sample was transferred by our inspector to an empty bottle in the driver's van before being sent to Ottawa for analysis. The empty bottle referred to had been opened and exposed to the dust of the road, and it is quite possible that the dirt reported as found in the milk may have obtained access to the milk during the transference referred to.

This explanation is made immediately upon the Department becoming aware of the facts and in justice to The Montreal Cottons Company, Valleyfield.
