COMMITTEE.

The ordinary weekly meetings are held every Friday, at 5.30 o'clock P.M., at which three shall form a quorum. The Committee may change the day and hour of said meeting and make them fortnightly during the summer. In the absence of the duly appointed Chairman, a Chairman for the day will be first elected, and the minutes of the last meeting having been read, the question is put by the Chairman "that they be confirmed."

If the minutes be objected to by a majority of the members present, the objection will be reserved for consideration, either at an extraordinary meeting or at the next ordinary meeting, as may be decided upon, and, if not objected to then, the Chairman will affix his signature thereto.
