

amined by a Committee. He shall, at the same time, present a list of Members in arrears, with the sum due by each.

Secretary. ART. 10. The Secretary shall keep a fair and faithful Register of all the Proceedings of the Society. He shall also keep a separate book, in which, shall be entered the General Rules, as they stand in the printed copy, and the Bye Laws, Orders and Resolves of the Society, noting such as have been annulled, altered or have expired ; which book shall constantly be on the table for the use of the Members. He shall also preserve all the books and papers, of the Society, excepting the Treasurer's books in immediate use, in a careful and orderly manner in the Chest of the Society, to which the President and himself shall each have a key.

Stewards. ART. 11. The Stewards shall attend to, and execute the orders of the President or Treasurer, in every thing connected with the appropriation of the money allotted for the expences of the House, for the expenditure of which they shall account to the Treasurer
