### SECTION XI.

No member in the Reading Room shall retain a newspaper longer than ten minutes after it has been applied for by any other member.

### SECTION XII.

Members, while in the Reading Room, shall observe strict order and decorum; they shall not engage in any conversation or discussion so as to distract the attention of readers. Smoking and other breaches of decorum of like kind are strictly prohibited.

### SECTION XIII.

Subscribers and visitors shall be subject to the provisions of Sections XI. and XII., in the same manner as members.

### SECTION XIV.

Any member or subscriber taking books or other publications from the Library or Reading Room, without the consent of the Librarian, shall be fined a sum equal to double ' ' chereof; or may be suspended from the privileges of the I 'e expelled, as the directors may determined, (see also B.

### RULE I.

Any person who shall be proposed in writing by two members of the Institute, in the same marner as a candidate for membership is proposed, under By-Law I., section 1; and who shall pay any of the amounts hereafter named, shall become a Subscriber under section 9 of said By-Law.

### RULE II.
