

SECTION XI.

No member in the Reading Room shall retain a newspaper longer than ten minutes after it has been applied for by any other member.

SECTION XII.

Members, while in the Reading Room, shall observe strict order and decorum; they shall not engage in any conversation or discussion so as to distract the attention of readers. Smoking and other breaches of decorum of like kind are strictly prohibited.

SECTION XIII.

Subscribers and visitors shall be subject to the provisions of Sections XI. and XII., in the same manner as members.

SECTION XIV.

Any member or subscriber taking books or other publications from the Library or Reading Room, without the consent of the Librarian, shall be fined a sum equal to double the value thereof; or may be suspended from the privileges of the Library, or expelled, as the directors may determined, (see also By-Law section VII.)

RULES AND REGULATIONS

FOR THE

ADMISSION OF SUBSCRIBERS.

RULE I.

Any person who shall be proposed in writing by two members of the Institute, in the same manner as a candidate for membership is proposed, under By-Law I., section 1; and who shall pay any of the amounts hereafter named, shall become a Subscriber under section 9 of said By-Law.

RULE II.

Male subscribers, over nineteen years of age, shall pay a sum of 75 cents per quarter, or \$2.00 per annum. (*Class A.*)
