

London Line Side-Tracked.

Toronto, in 1918, gave a favorable vote upon a bylaw providing for a hydro radial from Yonge street in Toronto London, Ont. It so happens that this line will not be the first built, but as far west as Port Credit the line is the same as that to Niagara Falls, so that Toronto's section goes on no matter what happens and Toronto's share of the cost will be the same as that in the Toronto-London project, namely \$4,240,196 with a margin of 10 per cent for possible higher expenses.

The project voted on in 1916, provided for a line from London to Toronto, 140 miles long and costing \$13,734,155, of which Toronto would pay nearly one-third. The Toronto-Niagara line will be more costly, but the city's share will not be increased. When the whole system is complete, there will be a complete \$30,000,000 system from Whitby, Port Perry and Uxbridge on the east, to Niagara Falls and Weltand in the Niagara Peninsula and to London in Western Ontario, whence a hydro line already runs south to Port Stanley.




