TORONTO-LONDON SUFFERED HYDRO RAILWAY GETS THE GO BY

First To Be Voted On, But Will Be Last To Be Built.

PREFERENCE TO FRONTIER Commission After Right-of-Way to Niagara—May Start Work in Fall.

TORONTO, March 17.—As a result of the favorable vote on hydro radicals, the provincial commission will proceed at once with the first section of the \$30,000,000 scheme which has been mapped out. This will be the section from Toronto to Niagara Falls, Hamilton, of which the cost will be approximately \$20,000,000.

KEMP REPORTS TO SIR THOMAS WHITE ON KINMEL RIOTS

Says Delays and Monotony Wore Men's Nerves. SHIPS NOT FORTHCOMING

Glogging of Flow Has Even Affected Troops in Belgium.

OTTAWA, March 17.—In the House of Commons this afternoon, Sir Thomas White read a cablegram from Sir Edward Kemp in regard to the riots at Kinmel Park. In part it reads as follows:

"Answering my inquiry further in information Kinmel Park disturbance, my cable March 7 should be read in conjunction with this, covers the ground pending through inquiry which is being carried on. Difficulties have been encountered in disciplining amongst Canadians has been considered at least equal to that of best imperial troops. Current in Canadian camps is accounted for by fact that the men have been away from their homes in Canada for periods ranging up to four years, or more, have suffered great privations, and are thoroughly homesick. A fact which is fully appreciated. It will be easily understood that men who have endured such hardships and monotony would, when they reached Kinmel Park, the last stage in England before embarkation, be prone to indulge in riotous behavior while they were waiting to be repatriated. Information on this point will follow.

"Armistice came at beginning of one of the most severe winters England has ever known. Men were continually cold and wet, with absolute lack of sunshine. Had we been there for a longer period, the men would have been less case for complaints.

"There has been general shortage of fuel, which has added to the men's discomfort. They have lived in camps for most part in tents, which is only accommodation, and British Isles and on continent have had some effect on men.

"In my cable to you February 25, I pointed out that we were short 5,000 in our shipment of troops to Canada for the first fifteen days of February. This was caused by military shipping board not being able to deliver ships, which had been specifically promised for certain dates. In some cases ships were offered which were, on examination, found to be unsuitable for military purposes. In other cases, sailings of ships have been postponed or cancellations of sailings causing vast amount of extra work in re-arranging of sailing dates and reopening of documents and correction of booking rolls.

"Delays and cancellations also lead to the postponement of sailing dates back to Belgium. Difficulties arose in connection with maintaining permanent crews owing to specially trained or technical personnel desiring to be returned to Canada in their order of priority and their patriotism. Inefficient personnel causes great difficulty in the work of the shipping board. I have been engaged in this work as well as staffs in general, including selection of all deserting and deserting men, and in many cases as much entitled as any to return are loyally and patriotically supporting me in endeavor to get troops back.

"Notwithstanding all difficulties with which we are faced, we will have succeeded in getting about 100,000 men moving from France to England, 80,000 soldiers and from England to Canada about 100,000 men, and we are considered here at any rate a remarkable achievement considering all circumstances.

"Sir Thomas White read a further cable from Sir Edward Kemp stating that not the slightest attempt was made in the riots to raid the girls' barracks, and that the girls were treated with the utmost chivalry.
