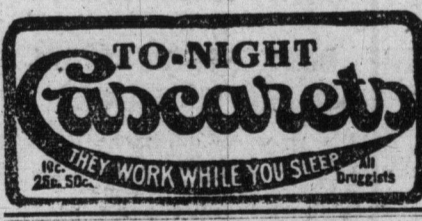
Two Hit by Train.
