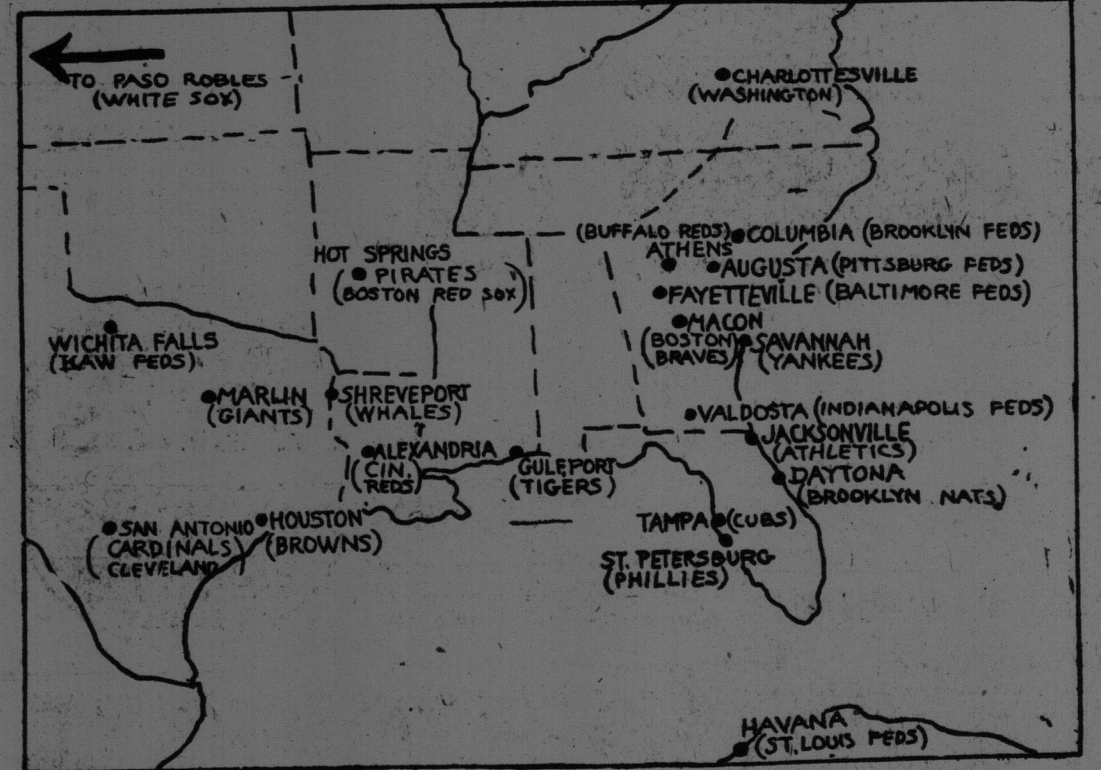


Famous Question Marks of 1915 Baseball Season--Here They Are; 9 of 'Em

Compulsory Physical Training In Australian Commonwealth

In the Australian Commonwealth the physical training of boys is now compulsory, and the commonwealth government possesses a director of physical training in the person of Lieutenant-Colonel C. Bjelke-Petersen. This gentleman, who has studied physical training schemes in England, Sweden, Denmark, France, Germany, Switzerland and Italy, has lately presented a report to the Australian minister of defence, in which he gives the fruit of his investigations and studies in the form of practical recommendations for use in the training schools and military forces of the Commonwealth. The report, which has been issued in the form of a White Paper, has just reached this country.
