RICKARD PLANNING OUTDOOR STADIUM

Would be Built in New York and Used For Football and Boxing

NEW YORK, Oct. 9.—Tex Rickard's next big undertaking will be to push through to completion his plans for a giant outdoor stadium which he hopes to erect next year somewhere in the metropolitan district. This was revealed by the promoter yesterday. He said he expected to make an announcement soon on the site for the prospective arena.

According to Rickard's tentative plans, the arena is to be essentially a football stadium which at the same time would be suitable for important boxing contests. It is to be patterned after the Yale bowl, only on a much larger scale, having a seating capacity of 100,000 for football games and about 125,000 or possibly 135,000 for fights.

IT'S TOUGH TASK

KEN WILLIAMS, who a few years back took the home-run crown temporarily away from Babe Ruth, has got an entirely new slant on baseball this season.

Recently, after he had popped up with a couple of runners on the bases, he remarked to me: "Pinch hitting is the toughest job in baseball. Without a moment's warning you are pulled from the bench

cold, to face some star pitcher who is going at top speed.

"In nine cases out of ten the situation is just as the name pinch hitter implies, the old pinch. Naturally you are tightened up and a batter never does his best unless he is natural.
