The nature and objects of the Bill are to increase the fees to \$10.00 on application, to \$5.00 on re-examination and to \$10.00 on registration, to provide for life membership of retired members; to increase present penalties, and provide new ones for violations; that all persons applying for registration must pass final examination; that incorporated Companies shall be bound by the Act and amendments, except in certain cases; that branch drug stores shall be in the immediate charge and under the bona fide conduct of a chemist registered under the Act, who must notify the Registrar of the opening of such branch store; and other minor amendments.
