By petition of the Pharmaceutical

Council of the New Brunswick Pharmaceutical Society, a Bill will be presented at the next session of the Legislature of the Province of New Brunswick, providing for the amendment of Chapter 14 of the Consolidated Statutes of New Brunswick, 1903, as amended.

The nature and objects of the Bill are to increase the fees to \$10.00 on application, to \$3.00 on re-examination and to \$10.00 on registration, to provide for life membership of retired members; to increase present penalties, and provide new ones for violations; that all persons applying for registration must pass final examination; that incorporated Companies shall be bound by the Act and amendments, except in certain cases; that branch drug stores shall be in the immediate charge and under the bona fide conduct of a chemist registered under the Act, who must notify the Registrar of the opening of such branch store; and other minor amendments.
