

SPIRIT OF TURPENTINE IN THE TREATMENT OF BURNS.—H. L. McInnis (*New York Medical Record*) says that spirits of turpentine applied to a burn of either the first, second or third degree will almost at once relieve the pain. The burn will heal much more rapidly than by any other treatment in the author's experience. He applies the turpentine as follows: After wrapping a thin layer of absorbent cotton over the burn, he saturates it with the common commercial turpentine, which is generally found in every house, and then bandages. Being volatile, the turpentine evaporates, and it is therefore necessary to keep the cotton moistened with it.

When there are large blebs, he opens them on the second or third day. It is best to keep the spirit off the healthy skin if possible, as sometimes pain is produced by its action.

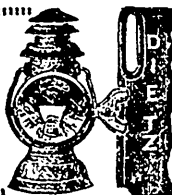
