

An Act to vest a certain portion of the allowance for Road in the Township of Trafalgar in the County of Halton, in the Municipal Council of the said Township.

WHEREAS it appears by several Petitions presented to Parliament Preamble. that a certain portion of the Road allowance in the Township of Trafalgar, between the Second and Third Concessions, South of Dundas Street, is not required for public use : And whereas a number of inhabitants, and also the Municipal Council, have petitioned that a certain portion of the allowance for Road between Lot Thirty-one in the Second and Third Concessions respectively, may be applied for the purpose of erecting a School-house thereon : And whereas it is expedient to give the Municipality of the Township of Trafalgar the power to dispose of the said Road allowance not required for public use, in such way as they may deem proper : Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows :

I. All that portion of the allowance for Road between the Second and Third Concessions, South of Dundas Street, in the Township of Trafalgar, between Lot Thirty-one in the said Concessions respectively, from the Westerly limit of the Bronté and Acton Road Company's Road, until it intersects the laid out Road across the Twelve Mile Creek, on Lot Thirty-one in the Third Concession, shall be and the same is hereby vested in the Municipal Council of the Township of Trafalgar and their successors for ever, with power to lease or otherwise dispose of the same as to them and their successors may seem meet.
