#87 - DUCK, John - The 1944 list shows 1 M, 1W, and 1 Boy, while the 1945 list shows 1M, 1W and 1 Girl. Please advise which is correct.

#93 YASSIE, David - It is noted that a Girl has been adopted by #95 and transferred to that number. Please advise if this adoption was carried out in strict accordance with the statutes governing adoption in the province of Manitoba. In order that we might maintain the identity of this girl, it would have been better to have given her a new number, and made a brief notation under Remarks giving the reason why the transfer was made.
