



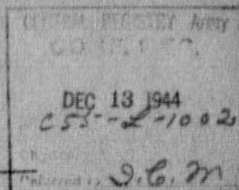



1. Further reference is made to your H.Q.C. 55-L-1002 (ICM) dated 27th October, 1944 and this Headquarters' letter numbered as above, dated 6th November, 1944.

2. Information received from the governor Quebec Civil Jail indicates that the marginally named other rank, who was sentenced to eight months imprisonment with hard labour on 19th August, 1944, had a very good conduct as he was admitted to prison.

3. This other rank will have completed one half of his sentence on 19th December, 1944 and it is recommended that his sentence be suspended effective 19th December, 1944.
