Q- Was the Warning read to him?

A- Yes.

Q- I show you Acknowledgment of Warning for Special Duty.

By whom is that signed?

A- The accused, B.V. Lameront.

Q- Did you see the accused sign that?

A- Yes.

BY PROSECUTOR :- I offer this as an exhibit.

BY PRESIDENT : Have you seen this, Mr. Frank?

BY DEFENDING OFFICER :- No, I haven't, sir.

Q- Was it fully explained to him?
