- 18. The Cabinet, after considerable discussion:
- (a) deferred decision on the proposal of the Minister of Labour that the Unemployment Insurance Act be amended to provide unemployment benefits for otherwise eligible persons who were unemployed because of illness or disability rather than because of lack of employment; and,
- (b) agreed that the Minister of Labour submit a report on the possibility of making Unemployment Insurance benefits available only to otherwise eligible persons who became incapacitated while unemployed.
