When two or more persons sign a note "severally and jointly," each is responsible for its payment.

A person indorsing a note, or writing his name across the back, becomes responsible for its payment. If, however, the person thus indorsing is not notified, when the note becomes due, of its non-payment by the drawer, he can no longer be held responsible for its payment. A partial payment of a note should alway, be indorsed on the same.
