

WEIGHTS & MEASURES.

That the Clerk of the Market procure Standard Weights and Measures, such as Half-bushel, Peck, and Half-peck, Gallon, Half-gallon, Quart, Pint, Half-pint, and Gill Measures; Weights, from fifty-six pounds to one ounce, to be kept in his custody, for the purpose of regulating the Weights and Measures within the said Town; and that the said Clerk shall, from time to time, examine the Weights and Measures used in Shops, Taverns, Warehouses, or elsewhere, within the said Town, kept for the purpose of weighing or measuring any articles whatsoever, offered for sale, and that any person or persons, having in his, her, or their possession or use any Weight or Weights, Measure or Measures, short of the said Standard Weights and Measures, shall forfeit and pay, for every such offence, a sum not exceeding Forty Shillings, nor less than Ten Shillings, over and above the loss of such Weights and Measures, which the Clerk of the Market is required to seize, and break, and destroy. That all Weights and Measures, not having already a Standard Stamp, hereafter to be used in the said Town,
