## CAP. XXVI.

An Act for granting to His Majesty certain Monies for the Service of the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty Four.

[12th June, 1834.]

MAY IT PLEASE YOUR EXCELLENCY,

V HEREAS it is necessary to make provision for defraying certain Preamble. Contingent Expenses and other Charges for the Services hereinafter mentioned; We, His Majesty's dutiful and loyal Subjects the Commons of His Majesty's Island of Newfoundland, do humbly beseech your Excellency that it may be enacted, and Be it therefore enacted, by the Governor, Council, and Assembly of Newfoundland, in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, that from and out of such Appropriation of Monies as shall from time to time be and remain in the hands of the £2192, 1, 11. Treasurer of this Island, and unappropriated, there shall be granted and paid to His Majesty, his Heirs and Successors, the sum of Two Thousand One Hundred and Ninety Two Pounds, One Shilling and Eleven Pence, Sterling, to be applied in payment of the following charges and services, that is to say:

The Clerk of the Legislative Council, for his services during the

present Session, One Hundred Pounds.

The Gentleman Usher of the Black Rod, Fifty Pounds, for his services during the present Session.

The Doorkeeper of the Legislative Council, for his services during Doorkeeper, £35. the present Session, Thirty Five Pounds.

The Clerk of the House of Assembly, for his services during the present Session, One Hundred Pounds.

The Solicitor attending the House of Assembly, for his services in Solicitor, £107, 2. drafting Bills during the present Session, One Hundred and Seven Pounds and Two Shillings.

The Serjeant at frms of the House of Assembly, for his services Serjeant at Arms, during the present Session, Fifty Pounds.
