CHAP. IX.

TTHEREAS an Act paffed in the forty-eighth year of his Majeffy's reign intituled, " An Act to continue an Act paffed in the forty-fifth year of his Majesty's reign, intituled, " An Act to afford relief to those perfons who may be entitled to claim lands in this Province, as heirs or devifees of the nominees of the Crown, in cafes where no patent hath iffued for fuch lands, and further to extend the benefits of the faid Act," will shortly expire, and it is expedient to amend the faid A&, and to continue part of the fame, Be it therefore enacted by the King's molt excellent Majefty, by and with the advice and confent of the Legiflative Council and Affembly of the Province of Upper Canada, conflituted and assembled by virtue of, and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled, "An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth year of his Majefty's reign, intituled, " An Act for making more effectual provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec in North America, and to make further provision for the Government of the faid Province," and by the authority of the fame, That fuch part of the faid Act paffed in the forty-eighth year of his Majefty's reign, as requires that the Commissioners therein mentioned, shall hold their sittings at the Town of York twice in the year, shall be, and the same is hereby repealed.

And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That from and after the paffing of this A&, the fittings of the faid Commiffioners shall be holden in this present year during the first ten days next succeeding the present Sefsion of the Legislature of this Province, and also during fifteen days, to commence on the first Monday of July next, and in each and every other year during the continuance of this A&, the said Sittings of the Commissioners thall be holden at the said Town of York, once in the year, to wit, during fif-

teen.
