#### A Bridge Without a Trace of Metal.

Of raw materials they are acquainted with but have no nails, no iron, no true wood; they are forced to rely entirely upon bamboo for the structural parts, and upon a rope of their own manufacture o affect the junctures. In spite of these limitations, they achieve highly creditable results. The span of a bridge over a river in the central part of the island is almost 150 feet. and the wdith of the roadway some four feet.
