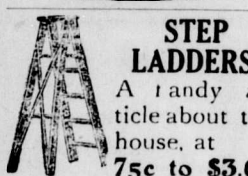

Chateau Louise at the north end. John L. Stoddard in his lectures alludes in part to Lake Louise as follows: The flawless glazier jewel, Lake Louise, is like a liquid sapphire set in a diadem of silvered peaks. Grand mountains, rise precipitating from its blue rim to the realm of ice, while the soft wreaths of their reflected forests, glaciers, cliffs and snow fields, sleep in its placid depths, and seem almost within our reach. It is a spot where every thoughtful soul desires to be alone. An hour's solitary musing here is worth a month of feverish life in the materialistic world so far below. I felt that this was one of nature's masterpieces, which she had reserved for her exclusive satisfaction.

Banff and Lake Louise are tourist resorts and this year they have been well patronized principally by Americans.

A trip up to Edmonton from Calgary was indulged in on my return journey. Edmonton like Calgary, is a fine city and is situated on the north Saskatchewan river, 200 miles north of Calgary. Edmonton is the gateway to the great Peace River district to the northwest of it, and it

stands in relation to this section, the same as Winnipeg does to the whole west, therefore the future is bright for this city.

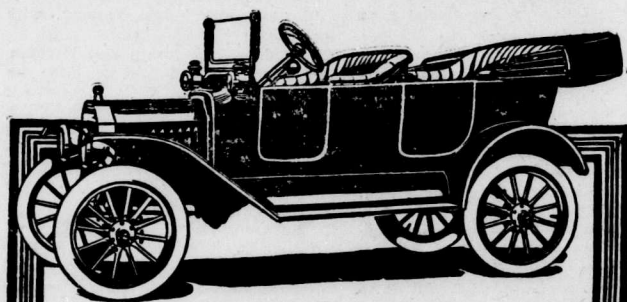
