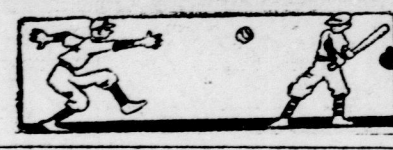

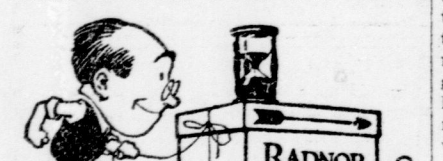

Willard Is So Fit He Lays Off Training

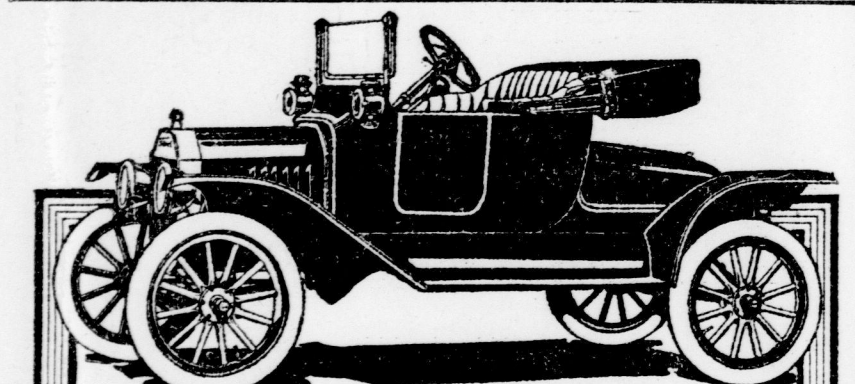
Johnson, However, Continues Stunts With Plenty of Road Work—Both Men Are Physically Perfect—Three Physicians Will Be at the Ringside.

The pugilists were examined and measured by physicians again last night. Each man is said to be in splendid condition with regard to their organs and muscles.

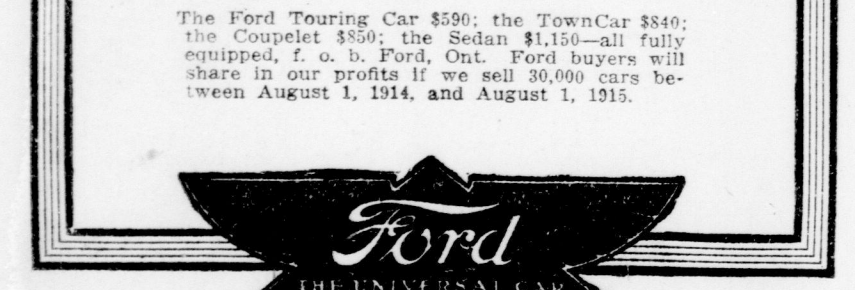
