CUT SHORT

BUCHAREST, June 2.—The Rus-

sian soviet government is withdraw-

ing its troops from the Bessarabian

frontier.

LONDON, June 2.—The appeal of

Horatio Bottomley against his con-

viction and sentence to seven years'

penal servitude, was lodged yester-

day. Alleged misdirection by the

judge and the excessive nature of

the sentence are the grounds of the

appeal.

MELBOURNE, June 2.—Professor Al-

bert Einstein, the relativity scient-

ist, will visit Australia early next year. He

is to visit Java in connection with

the solar eclipse in September, and the

universities of Australia have extended

him an invitation to visit this country,

which he has accepted.

MADRID, June 2.—The government

today decreed that articles imported

from nations whose currency has de-

preciated 70 per cent of the value of

Spanish pesetas shall henceforth pay

a surcharge in duty, which will be fixed

monthly according to the average rate

of exchange. The same measure is ap-

plicable to nations not entitled to lower

duties through the most favored nation

clause.

LONDON, June 2.—The Christian

churches of Great Britain have sent a

joint telegram to Premier Lenin of

Soviet Russia, protesting against the

attack on the Russian Church in the

person of Patriarch Tikhon. The mes-

sage said the conscience of Christen-

dom could not tolerate so great a

wrong.

It was signed by the Archbishops of

Canterbury and York, and the heads of

the Congregationalist, Baptist, Presby-

terian and Methodist Churches.

Cardinal Gasparri, papal secretary of

state, telegraphed the Archbishop of

Canterbury that Pope Plus was making

independent representations.

HONG KONG, June 2.—Forty per-

sons were killed and more than 100

wounded in the fighting on the Island

of Macao recently, which resulted in

the declaration of martial law. Macao
