TRIUMPHS OVER
O.A.C. DEBATORS

Local Orators Win Signal Victory in Inter-Collegiate Event.

VISITORS ENTERTAINED

Last night, before a large audience in the medical school auditorium, Western University debaters won the decision over the Guelph O. A. C. team in the hotly-contested event. The subject was: "Resolved, That Western Civilization is Perishable," the local university taking the negative.

This is a victory for the University of Western Ontario in that it is the first real intercollegiate debate ever staged here and the first debate of any kind held in the auditorium. G. Wishart, J. A. Simpson and E. T. Goring were the O. A. C. debaters, while J. Allen, A. Waring and N. Miller held the floor for Western. The judges were: Principal P. S. Dobson of Alma College, Professor D. H. Jones of O. A. C., and Professor Spenceley of the University of Western Ontario.

Dr. Fox, dean of the university, welcomed the Guelph team.

Guelph Opens.

The Guelph men were given the privilege of opening the debate. Mr. Wishart, the first speaker, outlined the great ancient civilizations. He emphasized the religious inertia of today, comparable to the Roman situation before the fall of that empire. Mr. Simpson referred to the biological and moral retrogression of these times when dollars were prominent in everything. He asserted that 75 per cent of the graduates of Harvard and Yale Universities were married, and that only 10 per cent of the graduates of the women's colleges of the United States married.

The final speaker for Guelph, Mr. Goring, pointed out that of the 1,700,000,000 population of the world, 950,000 were brown or yellow races with different civilizations from the Western civilization. These peoples were a menace to Western civilization, he continued.

Mr. Allen, on the negative side for Western, showed that the present civilization was an evolution of all the great civilizations that had preceded it.

Mr. Waring claimed that the ideals of the great civilizations of the past were imperishable, and that the permanent civilization of the Jews rested on a national religion. The world had that today and therefore our civilization was permanent.

Mistake Made.

Mr. Miller concluded for Western by saying that the old civilizations had made the mistake of not building on the universal brotherhood of man. These civilizations were ruled by fear and autocracy, which is fast being removed entirely today. During the intermission, the University Glee Club delighted with songs under the direction of Mr. Parnell.

After the debate, the members of the visiting team were entertained at Wong's by the Western team.
