An Old Boy.—Nova Scotia enjoys the honor of having the oldest working locomotive in America, the oldest working locomotive and the oldest driver in the world. It is now three miles of the past, still in working order, and employed at the Albion mines to convey coal from Stellarton to Pictou Landing. The locomotive, a six-wheeled engine named "The Samson," was built by the Glasgow Works in 1826, and was the first of its kind ever built in America. It is now in the hands of the Nova Scotia Railway, and is still in use.
