William Vaughan of Taracod, in the County of Carma then, Dollor of the Civill lam, hath undertaken to plant a Collony of he Maieffies Subsetts in New-found-land, & did fend thither in two fenera your sa great number of idle people, that in all that time had not done the any labor for the forefard Dollor, to the value of a penny, whereof I di acquaires him at my returns from that Country, So as he fent for them a home againe, and now bee is providing againe, to find this her this next year 2614. a greater number of people, then he did before, and is also wellplea fed to ensertaine any such as shall be willing to be Adventurers with him

eberein upon fit conditions.

And there are many other Right Honourable and Right Worshipful Lorde, & Knights, which are undertakers in the Newfoundland Plants tion: whose names are not herein mentioned, and it is well hoped, that diven other worthy persons will also put their helping hand to advance the same when they are given to and retand what honour and benefit may accen shereby. And of his Maieslies subjects of shis Kingdome, may bee willing so fee foorthofrom enery feneral County, but one good ship yocrely thisher with people and promisions sie for them, it will be then not onely a great be weer and benefit omto his Mai-fres Kingdomes, but also a great increase of Supping and Mariners, and the imploying and invicting of many then fand of poore people which new line chargeable to the Parishioners. The which may be castly performed by the able subjects, to set forth the Charge at first and so energ Parish to receive yearely their equals parts of the ben-fit which may accrew by the said stock; and thereby not only disburden themselves o Some of shose which lie chargeable onto them within their seneral Parishes but also recreit yeeld a great benefit to enery senerall County, though lie something remote from the Sea-coast, if they imply a dicrette hone mansherein, who may geerely be accountable to enery Parish, of the charge and likewife of the benefit. The which will not be any way burdenfome a hursfull into any; as the following discourse will plainely informe them.
