Scientific and Aseful.

CARAMELS.—One cup of molasses, one cup of milk, not quite a half pound of chocolate, not sweet; two cups of sugar, piece of butter size of half an egg. Cook thi by min-

FROSTINU GLASS.—Take an ounce of Epsom salts and heat half a pint of beer; work the two well together and leave until cold. Dab this mixture over the glass in the same manner as oil paint, and let it dry, then put a second coating over the first.

MACCAROONS.—A pound of blanched al monds pounded fine in a mortar, white of four eggs whipped to a stiff froth, two and a Lalf pounds of sifted loaf sugar; mix all well together, then add the whites of ten more eggs, beat all together until very light; drop with a spoon on stiff white paper and lay in a baking tin in a slow oven, after having dropped upon each a few small bits of sliced almonds.

TOMATO SOUP.—An excellent tomato soup is made in this way. It is so simple, and requires so little skill in its preparation, that it will prove acceptable to many: One quart of stewed tomatoes, strained, so that no aceds remain; add a generous quart of boiling milk, put a piece of butter the size of an egg in the tureen, add two tablespoonfuls of rolled cracker, and salt and pepper to taste.
