LOYALTY TO BRITAIN.

It is somewhat strange, perhaps, that an island whose commercial interests attach it so closely to the American mainland should hold so tenaciously its British loyalty and its English traditions. The constant presence in Bermudian life of the officers of the naval and military services would doubtless account to some extent for this undiminished fervor of attachment to the mother country. The growing popularity of Bermuda as a resort for Americans led several years ago to a prohibition on the part of Great Britain of the further sale of land to persons who w .e not subjects of Queen Victoria. This order has been resented by most of the Bermudians, and it has undoubtedly depressed the value of their real estate. Yet Americans must readily see that there was some propriety in the restriction. It could hardly be for the interest of Great Britain that the soil of one of her most important naval stations should be bought up and held as pleasure grounds for purposes of winter resort by people whose allegiance is to another flag. The exclusion of Americans from land holding carries with it no other disabilities or discriminations: for American visitors are welcomed in every way, and they always leave Bermuda with the hope of returning for another visit after a season or two. - Review of Reviews.

George Romney, the illustrious painter was born in the north of England in 1734 and began as cabinet-maker's apprentice, but discovered his talent by sketching a fair face in church, and turned to art.

After but little training he went rambling over the north country painting portraits, life-size heads for two guineas, full-length portraits for six guineas. At twenty-eight he found his way to London where, in a short wnile, he met with much success, becoming the rival of Reynolds in portraiture, and having the fashionable world at his feet. In fact, we are told that "Reynolds was not much employed as a portrait painter after Romney grew into fashion." With his popularity he increased his prices from time to time, until his annual income from portraits reached 4,000 guineas.
