## LOYAITY TO BRITAIN.

It is somewhat strange, periaps, that an island whose commercial irterests attach it so closely to the American mainland should hold so tenaciously its British loyalty and its English traditions. The constant presence in Bermudian life of the officers of the naval and mili. tary services would doubtless account to some extent for this undiminizhed fervor of attachment to the mother country. The growing popularity of lermuda as a resort for dmericans led several years ago to a prohbibtion on the part of Great lbritain of the further sale of land to persons who w .e not subjects of ()ucen Virtotia. This order has been resented by most of the Bermudians, and ithos undoubtedly depressed the value of their real estate. l'et Americans must readly see that there was some propricty in the restriction. It could hardly be for the interest of Great Britain that the soil of one of her most important naval stations should be bought up and held as pleasure grounds for purposes of winter resort by people whose allegiance is to another flag. The exclusion of Americans from land holding carries with it no other disalitities or discriminations; for American visitors are welcomed in cuery way, and they always leave Bermuda with the hope of returning for another visit after a season or two.-Kesicul of Reviews.
