1. Printed material

- 84. Following is a list of printed material that would be distributed worldwide to representatives of the Campaign's constituencies:
- (a) Personalized language versions of the major human rights conventions, especially the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, and increased distribution of these;
- (b) Update and reprint of the human rights resource kit for non-governmental organizations and its production in additional official languages;
 - (c) Media kits on selected human rights observances or issues;
- (d) Update and additional official language versions of <u>Human Rights</u>:
 Questions and Answers;
- (e) World Public Information Campaign on Human Rights Leaflet explaining the aims and purposes of the Campaign in all official languages;
- (f) <u>United Nations Human Rights Newsletter</u>: 4 issues per year (March, June, September, December) in all the official languages of the United Nations;
- (g) <u>United Nations Bulletin on Human Rights</u>: 3 issues per year, in all the official languages of the United Nations;
- (h) Fact Sheets on Human Rights: 6 new issues per year in all the official languages of the United Nations;
- (i) Proceedings of regional workshops: at least two issues per year, possibly in all the official languages of the United Nations;
- (j) Human Rights Studies, as mandated by the competent organs, to be issued in all the official languages of the United Nations;
- (k) <u>Ad Hoc</u> publications such as the booklet on the teaching of human rights, to be co-ordinated between the Centre for Human Rights and specialized agencies, such as UNESCO, in all official languages of the United Nations;
- (1) Update and production in additional official languages of the Catalogue of public information material on human rights, available from the United Nations.

2. Workshops and training courses

85. The Centre for Human Rights would organize regional workshops and training courses every year in various regions of the world on the basis of specific mandates by the competent organs, or as a result of requests by Member States or in co-operation with national institutions and organizations.
