

## ARTICLE VII

The Government of the Kingdom of Thailand shall exempt from customs duties, taxes and other charges of similar nature, technical and professional equipment and materials imported into Thailand, for the execution of projects subject to their re-exportation or to the termination of the useful life of such effects or to the disposal of same to persons enjoying similar exemptions.

## ARTICLE VIII

The Government of the Kingdom of Thailand shall exempt Canadian personnel upon their first arrival in Thailand and for a period of six (6) months thereafter, from customs duties, other duties, taxes, levies, and other charges of similar nature, on personal and household effects imported into Thailand for their personal use, including household appliances, subject to the re-exportation or to the termination of the useful life of such effect or to the disposal of said effects to persons enjoying similar exemptions.

## ARTICLE IX

Each member of the Canadian personnel may import or export free of customs duties, other duties, taxes, levies and other charges of a similar nature, a vehicle that conforms to Thai regulations for his or her personal use and use of his or her dependants. This privilege shall be exercised in accordance with regulations governing the purchase, sale or disposal of vehicles of experts who are posted in Thailand under the technical cooperation programmes of the Colombo Plan.

## ARTICLE X

The Government of the Kingdom of Thailand shall exempt funds, equipment, products, materials and any other goods imported into Thailand from Canada or any other country for the execution of projects established under any subsidiary arrangement from all taxes and customs duties. Inspection fees or storage charges and all other levies, duties, fees or charges occurring in Thailand, shall be the responsibility of the Government of the Kingdom of Thailand.

## ARTICLE XI

The Government of the Kingdom of Thailand shall facilitate for Canadian firms and Canadian personnel the re-exportation of their funds in accordance with rules and procedures laid down by the Bank of Thailand and consistent with the rights and obligations of Thailand as a member of the International Monetary Fund.

## ARTICLE XII

Upon request, the Government of the Kingdom of Thailand shall inform Canadian firms and Canadian personnel of local laws and regulations which may concern them in the performance of their duties.
