

as well as free medical, dental and hospital services. If participants are accompanied by dependents, similar medical, dental and hospital services will be provided for them and the host party will give all possible assistance in finding suitable accommodation for them;

6. apart from the expenses indicated in paragraphs (2), (3), (4) and (5), the receiving side will pay the visiting scholar the following allowances: in the USSR, 12 roubles per day; and in Canada an equivalent sum of Canadian dollars according to the official rate of exchange on January 1st of each year;
7. the sending side will ensure that the visiting scholar will have a source of income other than the basic allowance paid to him by the receiving side. All additional allowances which may be required will be paid by the sending side;

Nominations by the Sending Side

For the categories of participants mentioned in Section III, the nominations of scholars, with application forms as agreed to by both sides, must be submitted to the other side not less than three months prior to the intended date of arrival. Information submitted by each applicant should include a list of published books, publications and articles published relating to the projects proposed by the applicant as well as a comprehensive research plan and the date of the last relevant degree received.
