AGREEMENT OF CO-OPERATION REGARDING THE TRANSFER OF

PERSONS INCARCERATED UNDER SENTENCE

BETWEEN

THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA

AND

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE KINGDOM OF MOROCCO

The Government of Canada and the Government of the Kingdom of Morocco,

Desiring to facilitate the reintegration into society of persons incarcerated under sentence,

Considering that this objective may be attained by enabling persons incarcerated under sentence, with their consent, to serve their sentence of deprivation of liberty in the country of which they are nationals,

Have agreed as follows:

ARTICLE 1 DEFINITIONS

For the purposes of the Agreement, the expression:

A. "sentence" means any punishment involving deprivation of liberty ordered by a court on account of a criminal offence;

B. "judgment" means a decision or order of a court imposing an enforceable sentence;

C. "sentencing State" means the State in which the sentence was imposed on the person who may be transferred;

D. "administering State" means the State to which the sentenced person may be transferred in order to serve his sentence;
