*AIRCRAFT "NORTH STAR"

Mr. CASE:

1. By whom was the aircraft North Star designed?

2. What, to date, has the government spent on building this aircraft?

3. Has the government ceased to construct these aeroplanes? If so, for what reason?

Mr. McILRAITH: In answer to the first part of this question, I may say that the *North Star* is a Douglas type of aircraft designed by Douglas Aircraft Company Incorporated, and modified for Rolls Royce Merlin engines by Douglas Aircraft Company Incorporated, Rolls Royce and Canadair in collaboration with Trans-Canada Air Lines and the R.C.A.F.

As to parts 2 and 3 of the question, a statement was made by the Minister of Reconstruction and Supply on March 20 last, which will be found at pages 1540 to 1544 of *Hansard*; and in addition to that, a parliamentary return was tabled earlier this afternoon giving additional information in answer to the question.
