Dear Sir Arthur :-

I am writing for Mr. Massey concerning Sir Arthur Salter's visit to Montreal. I believe that you have been sent his complete itinerary, but there are one or two points which it does not cover and about which Mr. Massey wished me to write to you.

Arrangements are being made to have Sir Arthur speak to the Montreal Branch of the Institute of International Affairs on his way to New York after his Ottawa visit in order to avoid the clash with Professor Coupland's meeting. Although the date for the Institute's meeting has not been definitely settled, the 29th. has been suggested, in which case Sir Arthur would stay at the Ritz for that night and proceed to New York on the morning of Sunday, the 30th.
