QUALIFICATION FOR CERTIFICATE OF GRADUATION.

121. The conditions requisite to entitle to a certificate of graduation, are as follows:—

To count the qualifying minimum of the total number of marks allotted to the obligatory sections of the *full course* of each of the subjects which are specified as forming the obligatory course of instruction of the College, and *also* the qualifying minimum at the *final* examination of each obligatory subject in *whatever* class the subject may be completed.

The subjects and qualifying minimum are given in the subjoined table.

QUALIFICATION FOR "PASS," "SPECIAL MENTION" OR "HONOURS."

122. The conditions requisite to entitle to record on Certificate of Graduation of "Pass," "Special Mention" or "Honours" in any subject of instruction, are as follows:—
