QUALIFICATION FOR CERTIFICATE OF GRADUATION.

121. The conditions requisite to entitle to a certificate of graduation, are as follows:-

To count the qualifying minimum of the total number of marks allotted to the obligatory sections of the *full course* of *each* of the subjects which are specified as forming the obligatory course of instruction of the College, and *also* the qualifying minimum at the *final* examination of *each* obligatory subject in *whatever class* the subject may be completed.
