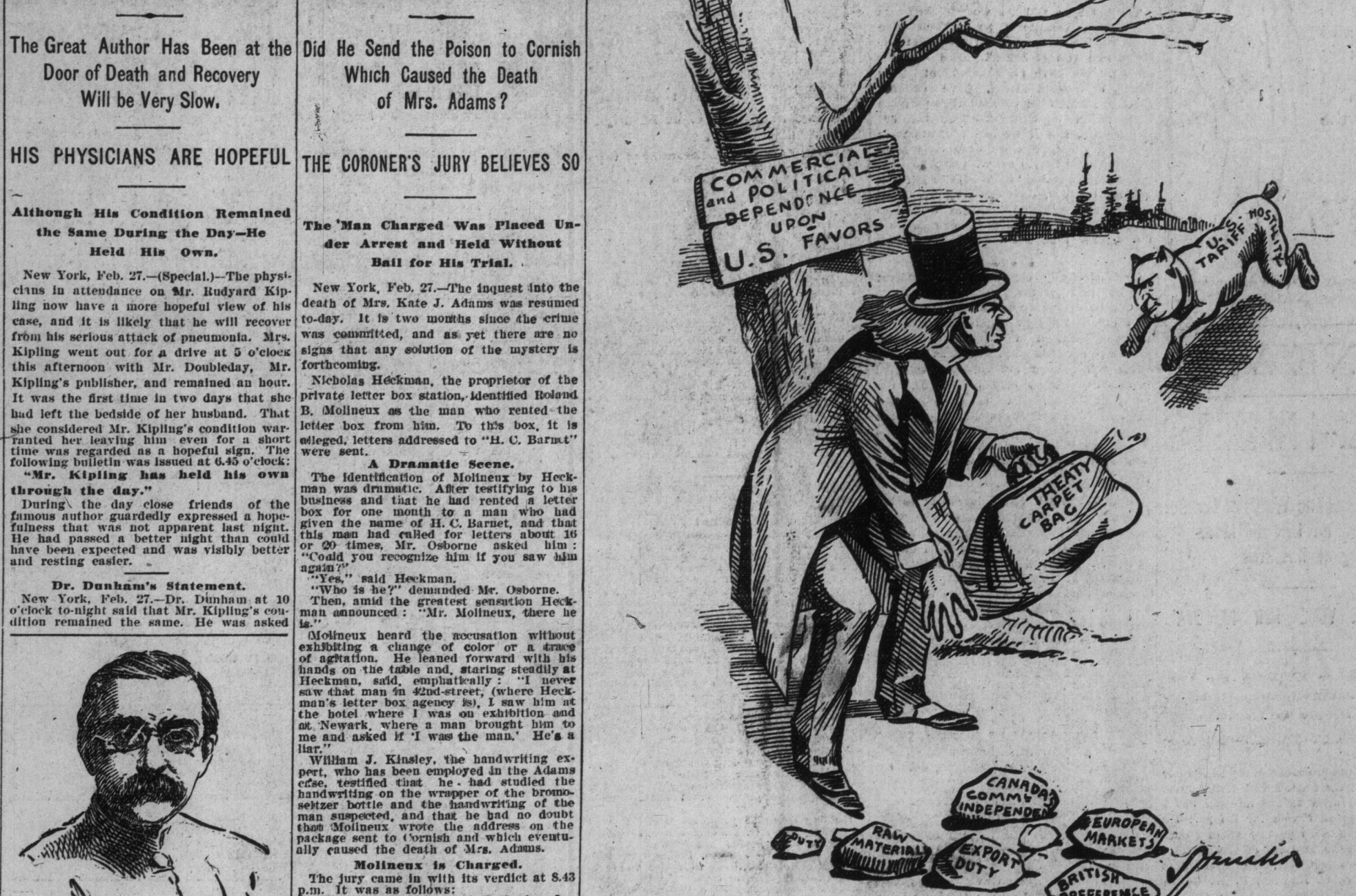

CUBAN WAR SHOULD TEACH CANADA.

A Vote of Thanks Moved It Was a Question of Finances-Outcome Hopeful.

The Garrison news room at the Armoures was filled last evening to hear Col. Hubert Foster, Q.M.G., lecture on "The Organization of an Army for War."

He discussed organization with respect to every sub-division of an army, as existing in the English service. Pressing need of organization in Canada was evidenced by the war in the Philippines, in which an army of 15,000 men had to take islands 400 miles away, defended only by an effective people; the result, "confusion worse confounded," the final salvation being due only to "luck and luck."

Chaplain-General N. G. W. He referred to the Philippine general as one of the officers of which he doubted the usefulness. Discussing Canada's position in case England went to war, he said unless Canada had a thorough organization of forces, she could not hope to help England as she would wish, or even defend herself.

Question of Money. In commenting on the address, and moving a vote of thanks, Col. Mason dwelt on the excellent points brought out, and was glad to see that the reforms were not only suggested, but likely of attainment. It was largely a question of money, because all the instincts of military heads and the governments were at one on the question. They agreed that the vast difference in the efficiency of British service. At the present time the British ships were terrible and organization poor, a vast difference from that of the recent Russian fleet. Canada at present resembled the condition of the British army at the former period. Lieut. Cox seconded the vote of thanks.

A BIG BUFFALO DEAL

The Entire Street Railroad System of That City Handed Over.

IT INVOLVES \$24,108,000.

Niagara Falls Park and River Electric Railway Company Goes Into the Bargain.

Buyers Are a Syndicate Composed of New Yorkers and Philadelphians, and All the Interests Are to be Consolidated Under a Single Management—The Several Railroads That Came Into the Amalgamation.

Buffalo, Feb. 27.—The Commercial this afternoon says: "The most stupendous business deal in the history of the City of Buffalo, both in point of public and private interests concerned, and in the amount of capital involved, is about completed. It involves some \$25,000,000 of capital. Briefly, it is the sale of the entire street railroad system of Buffalo and a number of suburban lines.

The deal includes the properties of the following companies: The Buffalo Railway Company, the Buffalo Traction Company, the Buffalo, Bellevue and Lancaster Railway Company, the Buffalo and Lockport Railway Company, the Niagara Falls Park and River Electric Railway Company (running along river bank on the Canadian side), the Niagara Falls & Clifton Bridge Company, and the Lewiston & Queenston Heights Bridge Company.

This immense combination of interests has been sold to a syndicate composed of New Yorkers and Philadelphians, and all of the interests named are to be consolidated under one management.

A summary of the capital stock and bond indebtedness of all the corporations involved, with the exception of the capital stock of the Niagara Falls & Clifton Bridge Company, which could not be consolidated, is as follows: Buffalo Railway Company (including Bellevue & Lancaster road), \$15,215,000; Buffalo & Niagara Falls Railroad Company, \$2,250,000; Buffalo Traction Company, \$3,858,000; Buffalo & Lockport Railroad, \$1,000,000; Niagara Falls Park & River Electric Railroad, \$1,000,000; Lewiston & Queenston Heights Company, \$250,000; making a total of \$24,108,000.

DEAD IN A CASK OF WINE
Strange Death of Frank Canessa at Buffalo—Was It a Suicide?

Buffalo, Feb. 27.—Frank Canessa, 38 years of age, was found dead in a huge cask of wine in the Buffalo Macaroni & Vermicelli Works this morning. Whether he accidentally fell into the cask or had let himself in to examine its contents will never be known. Although there was about a barrel of wine in the cask, it was not sufficient to cover Canessa's head, so that death must have been due to asphyxiation from the alcoholic fumes.
