warmed again by the sun next morning the mist evaporates and disappears. When warm air ascends, it not only passes into colder regions, but the very act of expansion from the warmth it receives lowers its temperature, and the vapor condenses and forms clouds. Clouds often appear to float in the air for hours, but the water particles falling slowly through the air meet with warmer and drier air, and so evaporate again and ascend. At the top of the cloud condensation occurs, and drops of moisture fall and, if striking the earth before they can evaporate, become rain. At the same time the bottom of the cloud vaporizes and rises, forming smaller clouds higher up; thus part of the clouds continue to ascend and become still cooler until particles of ice can get no higher—about six miles on a warm day. The average height of clouds is just a mile.
