the number of the other band.

I gave them, at their urgent  
request, a small quantity of  
twine for nets for the spring  
fishing, and a couple of dressed  
skins to make moccasins, as they  
do not hunt.

I Mr Robert Sinclair (of Ottawa),  
whom I consulted regarding the  
cheques you enclosed me, for the  
respective sums of \$70 & \$90,  
pertaining to the payment of the  
Black River Indians, placed the  
whole sum \$160, "as a refund  
of Indian expenditure"
