

EXTRACTS
FROM THE MILITIA ACT,
(CONSOL. STAT. CAP. 35,)
APPLICABLE TO VOLUNTEERS
IN CLASS B.

23. 2. And the Volunteer Companies and Corps receiving pay shall be known as Class A, and those receiving no pay as Class B ; And whenever the number of Companies or Corps or men in Class A falls short of that limited by the said section, the deficiency may be supplied by removing the proper number from Class B into Class A ; But in all respects, except as to pay and allowances, the provisions of this Act shall apply in like manner to the Volunteer Companies, Corps and men in both Classes.

24. Each Volunteer Troop of Cavalry, Company of Foot Artillery, or Company of Riflemen, shall consist of a Captain, a Lieutenant, a Cornet, Second Lieutenant or Ensign, three Serjeants, three Corporals, a Trumpeter or Bugler, and not exceeding forty-three Privates,
