CHAPTER VIII.

OF AUCTION LICENSES.

1. Auction licenses in the city of Halifax shall be granted by Auction licenses, the city council, and shall be made out and issued by the clerk of the licenses, upon payment to the city treasurer of a duty of twenty pounds, and every such license shall continue in force for one year.

2. The city clerk and the city clerk of licenses shall each for Fees for the entry and issuing such license and all proceedings connected therewith, be entitled to a fee of five shillings for the use of the

city.

3. If any person shall act as an auctioneer within the city Penalties. without being thereto licensed, he shall for every offence forfeit fifty pounds. But nothing herein contained shall extend to sheriffs or other officers selling under process of law, or the decree or direction of any court.
