Domecq Garcia; of Finance, Señor Herrera Vegas; and of Justice, Señor Celestino

Marco, are those particularly mentioned as being objected to.

The ex-President spent the last days of his power in signing thousands of decrees assigning positions to his political friends, which President Alvear will have either to accept or reject. If he rejects them the much talked of break in their friendly relations will become a fact, and a split between the two men now would be followed by a state of chaos in the country.

I am reliably informed that at a dinner party several nights ago, at which the former Under-Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs, Dr. Diego Molinari, was present. he used most violent language against President Alvear, saying that if he did not

change his tactics there would be a revolution.

The inauguration ceremonies on the 12th October ended with a parade of troops and contingents from the Brazilian, Japanese and Uruguayan warships, which came here specially for the occasion.
