

instructions prohibited your issuing such a license to any one who had not performed settlement duties without reference in the first place to, and authority from the Department; that you had also no right to accept from Mr McMullen simply the dues on timber cut in trespass, as it would appear from your explanations that Pine was so cut by McMullen and that you accepted merely dues thereon.

Your quoting the names of Burton Bros in your Return for June 1882 in connection with the timber cut, and not Mr McMullen's name to whom the license was issued by you,
